The Levy in 2008 was \$349,000. If you add 2% per year the levy would have equaled \$417,084 after 8 years. Because of the economy being in a recession the Town Board reduced the levy down to \$299,000 in 2014. The Board agreed in 2008 the day would come when the economy would recover

and there would be a need for a levy increase.
