EMERGENCY MEETING MINUTES

Monday, June 27th, 2022 7:30pm

Purpose of meeting: To discuss flooding on Peterson Road,
plugged culvert and beaver control.

Present: Don Hales, Justin Smith, John Enright and Amy Vukelich

Absent: Mindy Tix and Carol Pundt

Community members present: Debra Flam and John Vukelich

Don Hales called the meeting to order at 7:30pm with the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by Justin Smith and seconded by John Enright to approve the agenda. All in favor. Motion carried.

Don Hales opened the discussion by asking if everyone had gotten a chance to drive Peterson Road. Smith and Enright stated they had and Hales said he had contacted Holmwig to put up road closed signs which they have done. Hales stated there are a couple of options – 1. Open the culvert and let it run but that would flood the Carlson’s and Vukelichs which is not a good option or 2. Put in a second culvert with a beaver leveler for under \$5,000. Both options would also include trapping the beaver. John Vukelich gave the name and number of Jim Rasmussen, a local trapper. Smith asked if the second culvert would be used in a normal year of rain fall and Hales said it may or may not depending on amount of rain and if the leveler works and prevents beaver from plugging the culvert. Enright asked when could Holmwig put in the second culvert and Hales said by the end of the week. Hales will also contact Deerwood Fire Department to see if they could pump some of the water off the road. Amy Vukelich said that the Garrison Fire Department would also lend a helping hand if needed.

A motion was made by John Enright and seconded by Justin Smith to have Holmwig put in a second culvert on Peterson Road with a beaver leveler and contact Jim Rasmussen to trap the beaver. All in favor. Motion carried.

The emergency meeting adjourned at 7:45pm.
